We have a large festival bowl that you can play yard games in during the day.




EXPLORE THE GROUNDS

MONARCH HILL HEMP & CBD WALKING TOURS Friday & Saturday (Times TBA)

During this walking tour you will be able to see and smell beautiful hemp plants, their flower buds bursting with CBD sparkle. Enjoy some education on the CBD plant. Topics of interest may include farming practices, greenhouse production, terminology, and processing equipment and methods.

You may extend your walking tour with the wildflower butterfly walk to the back 20. On this ¾ mile walk you can hike up the hill and have a view of Eau Claire. Social distancing expected and respected. After your tour, come back to the booth and purchase products made right on the farm so you can experience the health benefits of CBD for yourself. OFF-SITE ACTIVITIES AROUND EAU CLAIRE

CANOE OR KAYAK IN EAU CLAIRE

- Lake Altoona Dam to Hobbs Landing (9 miles away)
- Harstad County Park to County Road K (22.5 miles away)
- Chippewa River Water Trail (4.2 miles away) through Eau Claire
- *Bring your own canoe/kayak (no businesses are offering rentals right now)

HIKING AT BIG FALLS PARK (19 MILES AWAY)

There no designated trails but hikers can easily walk a half-mile along the Eau Claire river, over sandbars and across rock. The falls area is a great spotfor wading in the river, sunbathing on sand and picnicking upon exposed rocks.

FERGUSON'S ORCHARD (8 MILES AWAY)

Stroll through a large pick-your-own orchard and find hours of fun for all ages in Apple Blossom Park (wagon rides, friendly farm animals, huge corn maze with socially-distanced paths and more).

BIKING & HIKING TRAILS IN EAU CLAIRE

The 70+ miles of bike trails in the Eau Claire area will connect you to scenic nature scenes, downtown life and everything inbetween. A few of the more popular trails/parks are listed below:

- Carson Park (3.9 miles away)
- Downtown Trails (5.2 miles away)
- Chippewa River Trail (6 miles away)
- Lowes Creek County Park (8.2 miles away)
